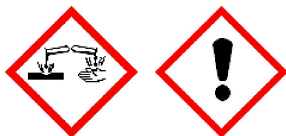

4. First Aid Measures

Emergency and First Aid Procedures:

In Case of Inhalation:

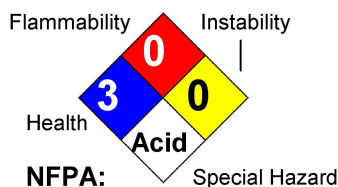
